This year's Footman James Sywell Classic Pistons and Props motoring festival returns to Northamptonshire's Sywell Aerodrome on September 27-28, and will this year include air displays from historic aircraft and aerobatics from more modern types. The Battle of Britain Memorial Flight is scheduled to appear on the Saturday with three aircraft (including Avro Lancaster I PA474), while the Sunday will be graced with a simulated dogfight from the Great War Display Team, which will be flying its Sopwith and Fokker Triplanes, BE.2 and others.
